

Singapore Wushu Team Glorious Return from the 13th World Wushu Championships

Since achieving 6 Golds, 3 Silvers and 3 Bronze medals at the 28th South East Asian Games in June, the Wushu Team has done us proud again by bagging 1 Gold, 1 Silver and 2 Bronze medals at the 13th World Wushu Championships in Jakarta, Indonesia. This is also our third Gold medal at the World Wushu Championships in 20 years!

The team of 6, led by Team Manager, Mr Ng Kee and coaches, Sheng Shijie and Yang Ning, competed in 12 of the 32 Taolu events contested at the championships which was held from 14 November 2015 to 18 November 2015. Four traditional events were added to the Championships this year (Traditional Xingyiquan, Traditional Baguazhang, Traditional Chunqiu Dadao and Traditional Shuang Jian).

Fung Jin Jie, won the first Bronze medal for the team at the Traditional Chunqiu Dadao event on the second day of the Championships.

Taiji exponent, Ho Lin Ying, took the second Bronze medal at the Third Set IWUF Compulsory Taijiquan event on the third day of the Championships.

Nanquan athlete, Tan Xiang Tian, bagged the Gold medal at the Traditional Xingyiquan on the third day of the Championships and subsequently grabbed another Silver medal on the last day of the Championships at the Third Set IWUF Compulsory Nanquan event.

The team had returned to Singapore and was warmly received by Wushu Sub-Committee Chairperson, Mdm Eng Ngiuk Lian, members of the secretariat and their family members on 19 November 2015.
