Summary of Financial Performance 财务业绩检阅

The Federation recorded Total Income of S\$1,678,824 in FY2021 and S\$2,195,579 in FY2020. 总会 2021 与 2020 财政年度的总收入分别为 1,678,824 新元与 2,195,579 新元。

The higher total income recorded in FY2020 was mainly due to 2020 财政年度较高的总收入主要是:

- (a) an adjustment of Fair value gain of S\$1,440,000 on investment properties during financial year; 2020 财政年投资性房地产的公允价值收益调整为 1,440,000 新元;
- (b) Income collected decreased by \$\$312,069 & subsidy received from Sport SG decreased by \$\$400,000 mainly due to cancellation of the major activities due to restrictions and safety measures imposed by regulations due to Covid-19 outbreak; 活动收入减少 312,069 新元及体育理事会的津贴减少 40 万新元,由于 2019 新冠肺炎疫情爆发后,受到一系列的限制和安全措施的影响,所计划的活动被取消或推迟。
- (c) There was no donation received during the financial year. 本财政年度没有收到任何捐款。

The Federation recorded Total Expenditure was \$\$874,555 in FY2021 and \$\$813,776 in FY2020. Total expenses increased by \$\$60,779 mainly due to gradual resumption of the activities as the Covid-19 restrictions relaxed. Overall, the Federation recorded a surplus of \$\$804,269.

1.0 OPENING 开场

CEO Mr Leow Meng Hong welcomed and thanked all for taking the time to attend the 2021 Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Singapore Wushu Dragon & Lion Dance Federation (SWDLDF) via online Zoom platform. He shared that the Organising Committee had decided to hold the AGM online only a few days ago for the health and safety of everyone in view of COVID-19 pandemic. He thanked them for their understanding and cooperation.

2.1 He congratulated Adviser Mr Ng Kim Leng, Jimmy and Vice Chairman Mr Swee Kay Seng, PBM on their being conferred the National Day Awards Public Service Medal (PBM) and Public Service Star (BBM) by the President of Singapore. He hoped they will continue to serve and contribute to the community and to our Federation.

2.2 Mr Ang shared that the AGM was initially scheduled to be held our Training Hall, followed by the Certificates of Appointment presentation (COAP) for our 27th Management Committee with Guest of Honour was Mr Eric Chua, Parliamentary Secretary for Ministry of Community, Culture and the Youth (MCCY). However, due to the increase in COVID-19, the AGM was shifted to online and the COAP postponed to Nov/Dec 2021 when the situation improved.

2.3 World Taijiquan Championship 世界太极拳锦标赛

Mr Ang shared that COVID-19 pandemic has caused most, if not all international and local events and competitions to be postponed or even cancelled. For example, the 4th World Taijiquan Championship (WTJQC) was supposed to be held in Italy in 2020 but was postponed due to the pandemic. IWUF will convene a joint meeting with Italy (2020), Singapore (2022) and Canada (2024) to decide on which country to host the WTJQC on which year. Other international competitions have been shifted online, eg the International WudeBei Traditional Wushu Competition 2021; the Asia Traditional Wushu Online Competition; and the 2021 China-ASEAN Taijiquan Online Competition.

Locally, our National Wushu & Sanda Championship was postponed due to 1 to 23 Dec 2021 and our Ngee Ann City National Lion Dance Championship was postponed to around Christmas in Dec 2021. 在新加坡,我们的年全国武术与散打锦标赛将延后至 2021 年 12 月 1 至 23 日举行。義安城全国舞狮锦标赛也延后到 2021 年 12 月圣诞节前后举行。

2.4.1 | Formation of Singapore Traditional Wushu Elite Team 成立新加坡传统武术精英队

In order to promote Traditional Wushu and carry forward the spirit of Traditional Wushu, the Federation formed the Singapore Traditional Wushu Elite Team. Now, there are six athletes being

selected and they will also represent Singapore in the Asian Traditional Wushu Online Competition. Eventually, the elite team will have 20 to 30 players. Selection is currently under way.

2.4.2 Appointment of Singapore Traditional Wushu Honorary Mentors Group

In hoping that the gist of the various Traditional Wushu skills are passed down to the younger generations, the Federation appointed 20 Masters from the various local Traditional Wushu schools as Traditional Wushu Honorary Mentors to provide advice to our Federation and guidance to our Traditional Wushu Elite Team.

2.5 Formation of Wushu Federation China-ASEAN (WFA-C) 成立中国-东盟武术联合会

Supported administratively and financially by Wushu Federation of China, the WFA-C promotes Wushu and facilitate wushu competitions in South East Asia, especially in SEA Games. The key appointment holders are: Chairman – Malaysia, Secretary – Brunei and Treasurer – Singapore.

2.6 Changes to Federation Constitution 修改总会章程

Mr Ang shared that a committee, comprising President, Vice Presidents, Chairman, Sec Gen, Treasurer and Chairmen of Wushu, Dragon Dance, Lion Dance and Traditional Wushu Sub-coms, is currently looking into amendment of our Constitution based on current needs and advisory from the Sport SG. As the amendment involved huge amount of information, an Extra-ordinary General Meeting will be convened in Dec 2021 / Jan 2022 to discuss and pass the amendment with input from MC members and representatives from Sport SG and MCCY.

2.7 Upgrading Programme at CC 联络所翻新计划

The above programme will take 2½ years and involves works to replace cables, pipes, aircon systems in the premise and big fans in the training hall. The targeted date of moving out will be 28 Feb 2022. With the help from Sport SG, we will relocate to Bedok Centre of Excellence (COE) at a monthly rental of below \$2,000.00, subject to approval. The total costs of upgrading and operating from Bedok COE add up to about \$300,000.00 to \$400,000.00, depending on the bid price after bidding closes. Fund raising will be discussed in due course.

Vice President Mr Kwek Hian Chuan Henry shared the current term of Management Committee has been a challenging one with events / competitions being postponed or cancelled. He believed that Wushu fraternity out there see us as leaders and look up to us for direction and confidence and encouraged all to persevere in promoting Wushu in Singapore.

- 4.1.2 In view of COVID-19 pandemic that most of our members have been badly hit, MC approved to waive the Federation's Membership Fee for FY 2020 and reduced Caiqing 2021 Admin Fee to \$50 (inclusive of GST).

On Sunday, 17 Jan2021, three one-hour Briefing Sessions, for 50 persons each, were conducted by President Mr Ang Mong Seng BBM at our Training Hall at 10.00am, 11.00am and 12.00pm respectively. 150 for our Members sent one representative each to find out more details of / apply for Caiqing Permit.

After closing, we approved 1,378 applications or one approval per site, with Offices (797 activities or 57.8%) and Factories (284 activities or 20.6%) topping the list. The balance being Shops in mega Shopping Centres, Temples, Hotels, and Others such as educational institutions, camps, CC making 21.6% of the total number of activities.

The Federation formed a task force and engaged MOE officers to explore ways to continue with NSG (Wushu competitions) amidst the pandemic. Eventually, the NSG (Wushu competitions) was successfully held from 31 March 2021 to 10 May 2021.

- a. After registration closed, each participating schools was assigned a time slot for sending its student athletes to the competition site.

- c. After all student athletes completed their routines, they took leave and student athletes from another time slot /school moved.

- d. The video-recording spanned over the period from31March to 8 April2021 for Primary Schools; and from12 to 20 April2021 for Secondary Schools and Junior Colleges.

- e. The video clips were then sorted out based on category and event type and sent for judging from 4 to 10 May 2021 by National Wushu Judges with national or international accreditation. All the video clips were viewed and scores awarded based on a set of judging criteria agreed upon.

This was a breakthrough, without which the NSG (Wushu competitions) would not have been organised successfully. This feat has never occurred in Wushu competitions worldwide. Five first-time participants also performed very well on their debut. All 14 athletes won at least one medal in this Championships.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2022

These notes form an integral part and should be read in conjunction with the accompanying financial statements.

1. General

Singapore Wushu Dragon & Lion Dance Federation (the "Federation") is registered in Singapore under the Singapore Societies Act 1966. It is domiciled in Singapore and its place of business and registered office is located at 50 Serangoon Avenue 2, #04-01, Singapore 556129.

The Federation has been granted as an Institution of Public Character ("IPC") status for the period 8 June 2019 to 7 June 2023.

The principal activities of the Federation are to unify various Wushu organisations of different schools, to promote wushu, lion dance, dragon dance, yinggong and qigong, to promote physical fitness and patriotism among Singaporean and to develop the martial spirit.

2. Summary of significant accounting policies

2.1 Basis of preparation

The financial statements of the Federation have been drawn up in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards in Singapore ("FRSs"). The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis except as disclosed in the accounting policies below.

The financial statements are presented in Singapore Dollars (S\$), which is the Federation's functional currency.

2.2 Adoption of new and amended standards

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous financial year except that in the current financial year, the Federation has adopted all the new and amended standards which are relevant to the Federation and are effective for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 April 2021. The adoption of these standards did not have any material effect on the financial performance or position of the Federation.

2.4 Foreign currency transactions and balances

Transactions in foreign currencies are measured in the functional currency of the Federation and are recorded on initial recognition in the functional currency at exchange rates approximating those ruling at the transaction dates. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated at the rate of exchange ruling at the reporting date. Non-monetary items that are measured in terms of historical cost in a foreign currency are translated using the exchange rates as at the dates of the initial transactions.

Exchange differences arising on the settlement of monetary items or on translating monetary items at the reporting period are recognised in profit or loss.

2.5 Property, plant and equipment

All items of property, plant and equipment are initially recorded at cost. Subsequent to recognition, property, plant and equipment are measured at cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses. The cost of property, plant and equipment includes its purchase price and any costs directly attributable to bringing the asset to the location and condition necessary for it to be capable of operating in the manner intended by management. Dismantlement, removal or restoration costs are included as part of the cost of property, plant and equipment if the obligation for dismantlement, removal or restoration is incurred as a consequence of acquiring or using the property, plant and equipment.

Depreciation is calculated using the straight-line method to allocate depreciable amounts over their estimated useful lives. The estimated useful lives are as follows:

Leasehold property
Furniture and other equipment

Useful lives 20 years 3 years

The residual value, useful lives and depreciation method are reviewed at the end of each reporting period, and adjusted prospectively, if appropriate.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognised upon disposal or when no future economic benefits are expected from its use or disposal. Any gain or loss on derecognition of the asset is included in profit or loss in the year the asset is derecognised.

2.6 Investment properties

Investment properties are properties that are either owned by the Federation or leased under a finance lease that are held to earn rental or for capital appreciation, or both, rather than for use in the production or supply of goods or services, or for administrative purpose, or in the ordinary course of business. Investment properties comprise completed investment properties and properties that are being constructed or developed for future use as investment properties. Properties held under operating leases are classified as investment properties when the definition of an investment property is met.

Investment properties are initially measured at cost, including transaction costs.

Subsequent to initial recognition, investment properties are measured at fair value. Gains or losses arising from changes in fair value of investment properties are included in profit or loss in the year in which they arise.

2.6 Investment properties (Continued)

The cost of major renovations and improvements is capitalised and the carrying amounts of the replaced components are recognised in profit or loss when incurred.

Investment properties are derecognised when either they have been disposed of or when the investment property is permanently withdrawn from use and no future economic benefit is expected from its disposal. Any gains or losses on the retirement or disposal or an investment property are recognised in profit or loss in the year of retirement or disposal.

2.7 Impairment of non-financial assets

The Federation assesses at each reporting date whether there is an indication that an asset may be impaired. If any indication exists, (or, where applicable, when an annual impairment testing for an asset is required) the Federation makes an estimate of the asset's recoverable amount.

An asset's recoverable amount is the higher of an asset's or cash-generating unit's fair value less costs of disposal and its value in use and is determined for an individual asset, unless the asset does not generate cash inflows that are largely independent of those from other assets or group of assets. Where the carrying amount of an asset or cash-generating unit exceeds its recoverable amount, the asset is considered impaired and is written down to its recoverable amount.

Impairment losses are recognised in profit or loss.

A previously recognised impairment loss is reversed only if there has been a change in the estimates used to determine the asset's recoverable amount since the last impairment loss was recognised. If that is the case, the carrying amount of the asset is increased to its recoverable amount. That increase cannot exceed the carrying amount that would have been determined, net of depreciation, had no impairment loss been recognised previously. Such reversal is recognised in profit or loss.

2.8 Financial instruments

a) Financial assets

Initial recognition and measurement

Financial assets are recognised when, and only when, the Federation becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the financial instrument.

At initial recognition, the Federation measures a financial asset at its fair value plus, in the case of a financial asset not at fair value through profit or loss (FVPL), transaction costs that are directly attributable to the acquisition of the financial asset. Transaction costs of financial assets carried at FVPL are expensed in profit or loss.

When financial assets are recognised initially, they are measured at fair value, plus, in the case of financial assets not at fair value through profit or loss, directly attributable transaction costs.

Subsequent measurement

Investments in debt instruments

Subsequent measurement of debt instruments depends on the Federation's business model for managing the asset and the contractual cash flow characteristics of the asset. The three measurement categories for classification of debt instruments are amortised cost, fair value through other comprehensive income (FVOCI) and FVPL. The Federation only has debt instruments at amortised cost.

Financial assets that are held for the collection of contractual cash flows where those cash flows represent solely payments of principal and interest are measured at amortised cost. Financial assets are measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method, less impairment. Gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss when the assets are derecognised or impaired, and through the amortisation process.

De-recognition

A financial asset is de-recognised when the contractual right to receive cash flows from the asset has expired. On de-recognition of a financial asset in its entirety, the difference between the carrying amount and the sum of the consideration received (and, where applicable, any cumulative gain or loss that has been recognised in other comprehensive income) is recognised in profit or loss.

b) Financial liabilities

Initial recognition and measurement

Summary of significant accounting policies (Continued)

Financial liabilities are recognised when, and only when, the Federation becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the financial instrument. The Federation determines the classification of its financial liabilities at initial recognition.

All financial liabilities are recognised initially at fair value plus in the case of financial liabilities not at FVPL, directly attributable transaction costs.

Subsequent measurement

After initial recognition, financial liabilities that are not carried at fair value through profit or loss are subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method. Gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss when the liabilities are derecognised, and through the amortisation process.

De-recognition

A financial liability is derecognised when the obligation under the liability is discharged or cancelled or expires. On derecognition, the difference between the carrying amounts and the consideration paid is recognised in profit or loss

2.9 Impairment of financial assets

The Federation recognises an allowance for expected credit losses (ECLs) for all debt instruments not held at FVPL. ECLs are based on the difference between the contractual cash flows due in accordance with the contract and all the cash flows that the Federation expects to receive, discounted at an approximation of the original effective interest rate. The expected cash flows will include cash flows from the sale of collateral held or other credit enhancements that are integral to the contractual terms.

ECLs are recognised in two stages. For credit exposures for which there has not been a significant increase in credit risk since initial recognition, ECLs are provided for credit losses that result from default events that are possible within the next 12-months (a 12-month ECL). For those credit exposures for which there has been a significant increase in credit risk since initial recognition, a loss allowance is recognised for credit losses expected over the remaining life of the exposure, irrespective of timing of the default (a lifetime ECL).

2.9 Impairment of financial assets (Continued)

For trade receivables, the Federation applies a simplified approach in calculating ECLs. Therefore, the Federation does not track changes in credit risk, but instead recognises a loss allowance based on lifetime ECLs at each reporting date. The Federation has established a provision matrix that is based on its historical credit loss experience, adjusted for forward-looking factors specific to the debtors and the economic environment which could affect debtors' ability to pay.

The Federation considers a financial asset in default when contractual payments are 60 days past due. However, in certain cases, the Federation may also consider a financial asset to be in default when internal or external information indicates that the Federation is unlikely to receive the outstanding contractual amounts in full before taking into account any credit enhancements held by the Federation. A financial asset is written off when there is no reasonable expectation of recovering the contractual cash flows.

2.10 Cash and cash equivalents

For the purpose of cash flow statement, cash and cash equivalents comprise fixed deposits and cash at banks which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

2.11 Government grants

Government grants are recognised as a receivable when there is reasonable assurance that the grant will be received and all attached conditions will be complied with.

When the grant relates to an expense item, it is recognised as income on a systematic basis over the periods that the related costs, for which it is intended to compensate, are expensed. When the grant relates to an asset, the fair value is recognised as deferred income on the statement of financial position and is recognised as income in equal amounts over the expected useful life of the related asset.

When loans or similar assistance are provided by governments or related institutions with an interest rate below the current applicable market rate, the effect of this favourable interest is regarded as additional government grant.

2.12 Building fund

The building fund was set up for the purpose of matching against the leasehold building. The building fund is amortised over the estimated useful of the leasehold building.

2.13 Employee benefits

a) Defined contribution plans

The Federation makes contributions to the Central Provident Fund scheme in Singapore, a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions to defined contribution pension schemes are recognised as an expense in the period in which the related service is performed.

b) Short-term employee benefits

Short-term employee benefit obligations are measured on an undiscounted basis and expensed as the related service is provided. A liability is recognised for the amount expected to be paid if the Federation has a present legal or constructive obligation to pay this amount as a result of past service provided by the employee, and the obligation can be estimated reliably.

2.14 Revenue recognition

Revenue is measured based on the consideration to which the Federation expects to be entitled in exchange for transferring promised goods or services to a customer, excluding amounts collected on behalf of third parties.

Revenue is recognised when the Federation satisfies a performance obligation by transferring a promised good or service to the customer, which is when the customer obtains control of the good or service. A performance obligation may be satisfied at a point in time or over time. The amount of revenue recognised is the amount allocated to the satisfied performance obligation.

Service Income

Revenue from services is recognised when the services are rendered and upon customers' acceptance.

Subscription

Revenue from subscription fee is recognised on a straight-line basis over the term of the membership.

Rental income

Rental income from operating lease (net of any incentive given to the lesses) is recognised on a straight-line basis over the lease term.

Donations

Revenue from donations is recognised when received.

Sport council grants

Sports council grants are recognised at their fair value when there is reasonable assurance that the grants will be received and all attaching conditions will be complied with. When the grant relates to an expenditure item, is it recognised in the statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income over the periods necessary to match them on a systematic basis, to the costs, which it is intended to compensate. Where the grants relate to an asset, the fair value is credited to a deferred income account and is released to the statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income over the expected useful life of the relevant asset by equal annual instalments.

2.15 Taxes

a) Current income tax

Current income tax assets and liabilities for the current and prior periods are measured at the amount expected to be recovered from or paid to the taxation authority. The tax rates and tax laws used to compute the amount are those that are enacted or substantively enacted at the reporting date.

Current income taxes are recognised in profit or loss except to the extent that the tax relates to items recognised outside profit or loss, either in other comprehensive income or directly in equity. Management periodically evaluates positions taken in the tax returns with respect to situations in which applicable tax regulations are subject to interpretation and establishes provisions where appropriate.

b) Deferred tax

Deferred tax is provided using the liability method on temporary differences at the end of the reporting date between the tax bases of assets and liabilities and their carrying amounts for financial reporting purposes.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are measured at the tax rates that are expected to apply in the year when the asset is realised or the liability is settled, based on tax rates (and tax laws) that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the end of the reporting period.

Deferred tax assets and deferred tax liabilities are offset, if a legally enforceable right exists to set off current income tax assets against current income tax liabilities and the deferred taxes relate to the same taxable entity and the same taxation authority.

c) Goods and services tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST except:

- where the GST incurred on a purchase of assets or services is not recoverable from the taxation authority, in which case the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of the expense item as applicable; and
- receivables and payables that are stated with the amount of GST included.'
- The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to the taxation authority is included as part of receivables or payables in the statement of financial position.

2.16 Leases

The Federation assesses at contract inception whether a contract is, or contains, a lease. That is, if the contract conveys the right to control the use of an identified asset for a period of time in exchange for consideration.

a) As lessee

The Federation applies a single recognition and measurement approach for all leases, except for short-term leases and leases of low-value assets. The Federation recognises lease liabilities representing the obligations to make lease payments and right-of-use assets representing the right to use the underlying leased assets.

Right-of-use assets

The Federation recognises right-of-use assets at the commencement date of the lease (i.e. the date the underlying asset is available for use). Right-of-use assets are measured at cost, less any accumulated depreciation and impairment losses, and adjusted for any remeasurement of lease liabilities. The cost of right-of-use assets includes the amount of lease liabilities recognised, initial direct costs incurred, and lease payments made at or before the commencement date less any lease incentives received. Right-of-use assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis over the shorter of the lease term and the estimated useful lives of the assets.

a) As lessee (Continued)

If ownership of the leased asset transfers to the Federation at the end of the lease term or the cost reflects the exercise of a purchase option, depreciation is calculated using the estimated useful life of the asset. The right-of-use assets are also subject to impairment. The accounting policy for impairment is disclosed in Note 2.7.

Lease liabilities

At the commencement date of the lease, the Federation recognises lease liabilities measured at the present value of lease payments to be made over the lease term. The lease payments include fixed payments (including insubstance fixed payments) less any lease incentives receivable, variable lease payments that depend on an index or a rate, and amounts expected to be paid under residual value guarantees. The lease payments also include the exercise price of a purchase option reasonably certain to be exercised by the Federation and payments of penalties for terminating the lease, if the lease term reflects the Federation exercising the option to terminate. Variable lease payments that do not depend on an index or a rate are recognised as expenses (unless they are incurred to produce inventories) in the period in which the event or condition that triggers the payment occurs.

In calculating the present value of lease payments, the Federation uses its incremental borrowing rate at the lease commencement date because the interest rate implicit in the lease is not readily determinable. After the commencement date, the amount of lease liabilities is increased to reflect the accretion of interest and reduced for the lease payments made. In addition, the carrying amount of lease liabilities is remeasured if there is a modification, a change in the lease term, a change in the lease payments (e.g. changes to future payments resulting from a change in an index or rate used to determine such lease payments) or a change in the assessment of an option to purchase the underlying asset.

Short-term leases and leases of low-value assets

The Federation applies the short-term lease recognition exemption to its short-term leases of machinery (i.e. those leases that have a lease term of 12 months or less from the commencement date and do not contain a purchase option). It also applies the lease of low-value assets recognition exemption to leases of office equipment that are considered to be low value. Lease payments on short-term leases and leases of low value assets are recognised as expense on a straight-line basis over the lease term.

b) As lessor

Leases in which the Federation does not transfer substantially all the risks and rewards incidental to ownership of an asset are classified as operating leases. Rental income arising from operating leases on the Federation's investment properties is accounted for on a straight-line basis over the lease terms. Initial direct costs incurred in negotiating and arranging an operating lease are added to the carrying amount of the leased asset and recognised over the lease term on the same basis as rental income. Contingent rents are recognised as revenue in the period in which they are earned.

3. Significant accounting judgments and estimates

The preparation of the Federation's financial statements requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of revenues, expenses, assets and liabilities, and the disclosure of contingent liabilities at the end of each reporting period. Uncertainty about these assumptions and estimates could result in outcomes that require a material adjustment to the carrying amount of the asset or liability affected in the future periods.

3.1 Judgments made in applying accounting policies

The management is of the opinion that there are no significant judgements made in applying accounting estimates and policies that have a significant risk of causing a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities within the next financial year.

3.2 Key sources of estimation uncertainty

The key assumptions concerning the future and other key sources of estimation uncertainty at the end of the reporting period are discussed below. The Federation based its assumptions and estimates on parameters available when the financial statements were prepared. Existing circumstances and assumptions about future developments, however, may change due to market changes or circumstances arising beyond the control of the Federation. Such changes are reflected in the assumptions when they occur.

Useful lives of property, plant and equipment

The useful life of an item of plant and equipment is estimated at the time the asset is acquired and is based on historical experience with similar assets and takes into account anticipated technological or other changes. If changes occur more rapidly than anticipated or the asset experiences unexpected level of wear and tear, the useful life will be adjusted accordingly. The carrying amount of the Federation's property, plant and equipment as at 31 March 2022 was S\$101,100 (31 March 2021: S\$203,283) (Note 10).

20. Financial risk management

The Federation is exposed to financial risks arising from its operations and the use of financial instruments. The key financial risks included market risk (including currency risk, interest rate risk and price risk), credit risk, liquidity risk and capital risk. The committee members carried out their financial risk management in accordance with established policies and procedures.

The following sections provide the Federation's exposure to the above-mentioned financial risks and the objectives, policies and processes for the management of these risks.

(a) Market risk

(i) Currency risk

The Federation's business operations are not exposed to significant foreign currency risk as all the business activities are denominated in Singapore dollar.

(ii) Interest rate risk

The interest rate risk exposure arises mainly from changes in floating interest rate. The Federation is not exposed to the significant interest rate risk as it does not have any significant interest-bearing assets or liabilities.

(iii) Price risk

The Federation is not exposed to price risk as it does not hold any listed securities.

(b) Credit risk

Credit risk is a risk of loss that may arise on outstanding financial instruments should a counterpart default on its obligations. The Federation's exposures to credit risk arise primarily from trade and other receivables.

The Federation's objective is to seek continual revenue growth while minimising losses incurred due to increase in credit risk exposure. The Federation trades with all third parties but will only provide credit terms upon approval of the management. The receivable balances are monitored on an ongoing basis with the result that the Federation's exposure to bed debts is not significant.

Exposure to credit risk

At the reporting date, the Federation's maximum exposure to credit risk is represented by the carrying value of each class of financial assets recognised in the statement of financial position.

(c) Liquidity risk

Liquidity risk is the risk that the Federation will encounter difficulty in meeting financial obligation due to shortage of funds. The Federation's exposure to liquidity risk arises primarily from mismatches of collections and payments timing. The Federation's objective is to maintain a balance between funding through business and flexibility through the use of stand-by credit facilities.

The Federation's liquidity risk management policy is to maintain sufficient liquid financial assets and facilities through stand-by credit facilities to pay for liabilities that are due in the next twelve months.

(d) Capital risk

The Federation's objectives when managing funds are to ensure that the Federation is adequately funded and to maintain an optimal fund structure by raising-fund activities when necessary.

23. Fund management

The Federation's objectives when managing funds are to safeguard the Federation's ability to continue as a going concern, to support the Federation's stability and growth and to provide funds for the purpose of strengthening the Federation's risk management capability. The Federation actively and regularly reviews and manages its funds to ensure optimal structure taking into consideration the future requirements of the Federation and funds efficiency, prevailing and projected profitability, projected operating cash flows, projected capital expenditures and projected strategic investment opportunities.

The capital structure of the Federation consists of accumulated funds as shown in the statement of financial position. The Federation's overall strategy remained unchanged from 2021.

The Federation is not subject to any externally imposed capital requirement for the financial years ended 31 March 2022 and 2021.

In accordance with Article 58 of the Constitution, in the event of the Federation being dissolved in accordance with Article 57, all debts and liabilities legally incurred on behalf of the Federation shall be fully discharged. The remaining funds shall be distributed to other charities or Institutions of a Public Character (IPCs) approved under the Charities Act.

24. Authorisation of financial statements for issue

The financial statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2022 were authorised for issue in accordance with a resolution of the Committee Members of the Federation on the date of the Management Committee's Statement.
